HEB Website

Page 1: About HEB

Hero Section

1. Create a full-width Hero Section at the top of the page.

Requirements:

- Hero banner should support both image and video background options.
- Use a high-quality HEB-related image or cultural event visual.
- Add a dark black gradient overlay at the bottom of the banner for text readability.
- Banner must use a full rectangular layout with no curved edges.
- Hero section should feel immersive and modern similar to premium institutional websites.

Content:

- Main Title:
“About HEB”

Typography Requirements:

- Title must be centered vertically and horizontally.
- Large bold typography.
- Follow the HEB website typography style and branding.

Animations:

- Smooth fade-in animation for title.
- Subtle parallax scrolling effect for banner.
- Smooth page load transition.

Responsive Behaviour:

- Desktop:
 - Full immersive banner.
- iPad:
 - Slightly reduced banner height while maintaining proportions.
- Mobile:
 - Optimised crop positioning to ensure title visibility.

Backend Requirements:

- Admins must be able to:
 - Replace banner image/video.
 - Edit title text.
 - Enable or disable Hero Section.

Our Story Section

2. Create an “Our Story” section below the Hero Section.

Desktop Layout

- Two-column layout:
 - Left side: Text content
 - Right side: Image

Content Requirements

- Text block should support approximately 150–200 words.
- Body text should:
 - Have proper line spacing.
 - Not stretch too wide across the screen.
 - Follow proper content padding.

Image Requirements

- Use a relevant HEB-related image.
- Image should:
 - Be high resolution.
 - Have slightly rounded corners.
 - Maintain consistent aspect ratio.

Button Requirements

Below the text, include a button:

- “View HEB History”

Button Behaviour:

- Redirect users to:
 - HEB History page
 OR
 - PDF document

Animation Requirements

- Fade-in animation while scrolling.
- Smooth button hover animation.

Responsive Behaviour

iPad Version

- Image should stack below the text.

Mobile Version

Layout should stack vertically in the following order:

1. Title
2. Image
3. Body text
4. Button

Backend Requirements

Admins must be able to:

- Edit text content.
- Replace image.
- Update button link.
- Enable or disable section.

Vision, Mission & Motto Section

3. Create a dedicated section for:
 - Vision
 - Mission
 - Motto

Desktop Layout

- Three equal cards displayed horizontally.

Each Card Should Include

- Title
- Short description/body text

Design Requirements

- Clean and minimal layout.
- Equal spacing between cards.
- Consistent typography hierarchy.
- Subtle hover animation.

Optional:

- Small icon above each title.

Responsive Behaviour

iPad Version

- Two cards on first row.
- One card centered below.

Mobile Version

- Cards stacked vertically.

Backend Requirements

Admins must be able to:

- Edit titles.
- Edit descriptions.
- Add or replace icons.
- Enable or disable individual cards.

Milestones Section

4. Create a “Milestones” section showcasing important moments in HEB history.

Layout Options

- Horizontal timeline
OR
- Responsive milestone grid

Each Milestone Should Include

- Year
- Event title
- Short description
- Small icon or image

Design Requirements

- Modern and clean timeline/grid design.
- Milestones should feel visually connected.
- Hover interaction for milestone cards.

Animation Requirements

- Fade-in animation while scrolling.
- Smooth timeline transition animations.

Responsive Behaviour

Desktop Version

- Horizontal timeline or multi-column grid.

iPad Version

- Two-column milestone grid.

Mobile Version

- Single-column stacked layout.

Backend Requirements

Admins must be able to:

- Add milestones.
- Edit milestone content.
- Upload icons/images.
- Reorder milestones.
- Remove milestones.

Page 2: Our Management

Hero Banner

1. Create a full-width banner at the top of the page.

Requirements

- Banner title:
“Our Management”
- Title must:
 - Be centered.
 - Large and bold.
- No additional description text required.

Design Requirements

- Background should support image or subtle texture.
- Black gradient overlay for readability.
- Full rectangular layout.

Responsive Behaviour

Desktop Version

- Full-width immersive banner.

iPad Version

- Slightly reduced banner height.

Mobile Version

- Optimised crop positioning.

Backend Requirements

Admins must be able to:

- Replace banner image.
- Edit banner title.
- Enable or disable Hero Banner.

Board Members Section

2. Create a “Board Members” section below the Hero Banner.

Section Title

“Board Members”

Tabs Required

- HEB
- HAB
- HEB Ashram

Tab Behaviour

- Only one tab active at a time.
- Active tab should be visually highlighted.
- Smooth tab switching animation.

Desktop Layout

Each tab should display a two-column table layout.

Table Structure

- Left Column:
 - Member Name
 - Bold typography
 - Slightly larger text size
- Right Column:
 - Member Role/Designation
 - Regular font weight
 - Slightly smaller text size

Design Requirements

- Proper spacing between rows.
- Clean alignment.
- Divider lines between entries.
- Responsive table width.

iPad Version

- Maintain the same two-column table structure.
- Ensure responsive spacing and readability.
- Tabs should remain visible and touch-friendly.

Mobile Version

For mobile view, the Board Members section should use a dropdown-based layout.

Requirements

- Dropdown remains closed by default.
- Users tap the dropdown header to expand the list.
- Active dropdown should be visually highlighted.

- Add new tabs if required.

Section Title

Tabs Required

- Sri Mariamman Temple
- Sri Srinivasa Perumal Temple
- Sri Sivan Temple
- Sri Vairavimada Kaliyamman Temple

Tab Behaviour

- Active tab visually highlighted.
- Smooth switching animation.
- Responsive scrolling tabs for smaller devices.

Desktop Layout

Each tab should display the same two-column table format as the Board Members section.

Table Structure

- Left Column:
 - Committee Member Name
 - Bold typography
 - Slightly larger font size
- Right Column:
 - Role / Designation
 - Regular font weight
 - Slightly smaller text size

Design Requirements

- Consistent spacing.
- Clean alignment.
- Responsive table layout.
- Divider lines between rows.

iPad Version

- Maintain responsive two-column table layout.

- Ensure proper spacing and readability.
- Tabs should remain touch-friendly.

Mobile Version

For mobile view, the Temple Committee Members section should use a dropdown-based layout.

- Edit member details.
- Reorder entries.
- Add or remove temple tabs.

Page 3: Annual Reports

Header Section

1. Create a simple page header.

Requirements

- Title:
 - “Annual Reports”
- No Hero Banner required.
- Minimal and clean layout.
- Proper top and bottom spacing.

Annual Reports Listing Section

2. Create a report listing/grid section.

Each Report Item Should Include

- Report title
Example:
“Annual Report 2025”
- PDF icon or thumbnail preview
- Optional short description
- Download/View button

Functionality

Clicking the report item should:

- Open PDF in a new tab
OR
- Download PDF directly

Design Requirements

- Clean card-based layout.
- Proper spacing between report items.
- Hover animation for desktop view.
- Consistent thumbnail sizing.

Desktop Version

- Multi-column grid layout
OR
- Structured vertical list layout

iPad Version

- Responsive two-column grid layout.

Mobile Version

- Single-column stacked layout.

Backend Requirements

Admins must be able to:

- Upload PDF reports.
- Edit report titles.
- Replace thumbnails/icons.
- Reorder reports.
- Remove reports.
- Add optional descriptions.

Performance Requirements

- PDF files should load efficiently.
- Optimise thumbnails for faster loading.
- Lazy load report thumbnails where necessary.
