

TICKET SALES PAGE

1. Secondary Navigation Bar

- White background
- Maroon text
- Clean and minimal design style
- Smooth transition when navigating between sections
- Navigation items should remain evenly spaced and aligned consistently across desktop and mobile

2. Banner Section

- Title: "Ticket Sales"
- Main status display below title:
 - "Open Now"
 - OR "Opening Soon" with live countdown timer
 - Optional: display registration closing date if relevant

Status section must be dynamic:

- Admin should be able to switch between "Open Now" and "Opening Soon"
- Countdown timer should update automatically in real time
- Closing date should only appear when enabled

Background design:

- Full-width immersive banner
- Clean gradient transition into next section (Maroon)
- Optional subtle motion/animation in background

3. Registration / Ticket Layout

- Card Design:
 - Long rectangular cards instead of square cards. With dropdown to expand. After expanding, there will be date of the event and timing. Below that will be a two column
 - Left Column: Sub header, with a body text
 - Right Column: Requirements
 - Price and CTA button "Book Your Slots"
 - Stacked up vertically
 - Clear hierarchy between title, description, and CTA button
- Each card can represent:
 - Angaprathachinam
 - Kumbiduthanam
 - Paal Kudam
 - Fire Walking (Male)
 - Walking around fire pit (Female)
- Registration cards must be fully dynamic in the backend system.

- Admin should be able to:
 - Add or remove cards anytime
 - Set the ticket sales opening date and time
 - Set the ticket sales closing date and time
 - Control when the “Purchase Ticket” or “Book Slot” button appears
- Once registration closes:
 - The button text should automatically change (e.g. “Closed”, “Sold Out”, or “Registration Ended”)
 - Closing date can optionally be displayed to users
- All settings and controls must be manageable directly from the backend without requiring developer assistance.
- Card Behaviour:
 - Hover animation on desktop
 - Slight elevation/shadow effect on interaction
 - Mobile layout should stack neatly with proper spacing

4. Booking Steps Section

Create a vertical step-by-step booking guide

- Structure:
 - Step number displayed on the left side
 - Title beside the step number
 - Supporting body text below each title

Example:

- *Step 1 — Select Registration Type*
- *Step 2 — Fill in Personal Details*
- *Step 3 — Make Payment*
- *Step 4 — Receive Confirmation*

- Layout Requirements:
 - Steps must flow vertically down the page
 - Do not confine steps inside separate boxed containers
 - Maintain clean spacing between each step
- Scroll Interaction:
 - Active step should highlight while scrolling
 - Clear visual progression between steps
 - Connecting vertical line can animate as user scrolls down
 - Previously completed steps can remain partially highlighted
